#### WR CUSTOM GUITARS

Bill Russo, owner and Master Luthier at WR Custom Guitars, has been building guitars for 20 years from his quiet shop tucked away in the hills of western Maine. Over that time, he has created hundreds of guitars that are as much a piece of fine art as they are a functioning, high-quality musical instrument. Bill's career started out in woodwork several years ago and for many years he found success as a custom cabinet maker. His passion for both woodworking and guitars eventually led him to the seemingly obvious decision to open WR Custom Guitars and take on lutherie as his full-time job.

Bill learned the basics of building guitars from books and from discussing techniques with other luthiers, but admits that being out in the shop building guitars was the best form of education. Each guitar poses a new set of challenges and early on, not every WR Custom was exceptional. Instead of becoming discouraged, Bill took the lessons learned from previous builds and applied his new knowledge to the next build. Fast forward to today, all of his guitars are exceptional, but he still continues to strive to make the next one better than the last.

At WR Custom Guitars, the sky is the limit when it comes to custom builds. Bill offers any standard size guitar from Parlor to Dreadnought and everything in between. As far as materials you can choose from his vast inventory for the custom build of your dreams.


We will miss you and regret having to close the last BMAM jams of the season, and we hope all pickers stay safe during this difficult time.

In addition to custom builds, WR Custom Guitars also offers a builder's workshop where the student is guided through the guitar building process from start to finish. You choose the materials, finish and even custom marquetry if you so desire.

Over a 5-day period the student receives one on one instruction to ensure the guitar is built to the same high-quality standard as a custom build. The student does everything with the exception of finish, which Bill completes due to the complexity of that step. Once it is cured and polished, the student takes delivery of the guitar with the pride of having built something incredible with their own hands.
